Who are we?

- About 120 school counselors
 - 15 junior high schools
 - 9 high schools
 - Roosevelt/YESS
 - Unfortunately, not in elementary schools
- Ratios
 - Staffed at 1 counselor to 375 students with no less than 2 counselors at a school.
 - Utah Model-recommends 1:350
 - American School Counselor Association (ASCA)-recommends 1:250
